

Shasta Professional Eye Care Center Insurance Participation:

Vision Insurance: Our office accepts most vision insurance plans. You may have vision insurance separate from your major medical plan. Vision insurance is utilized for a comprehensive eye examination for ocular wellness. Some vision plans also allow for optical benefits, which can be used to supplement the cost of vision correction via glasses and/or contact lenses.

Major Medical Insurance: Our office accepts most major medical insurance plans. We will bill all pertinent medical charges through your major medical.

Comprehensive Eye Examinations: Routine annual eye examinations are billable to your vision insurance. You will be responsible for any co-pay at the time of examination. In the event that pathology is detected during a routine eye exam, additional testing or procedures may be indicated.

Additional Testing and Procedures are at an additional cost and will be billed to your major medical.

Pathology Focused Eye Examination: Examinations for a medical complaint will be billed through your major medical insurance.

Medical Diagnosis: Diagnosis by your doctor of a medical condition during a Comprehensive Eye Examination or Pathology Focused Eye Examination.

Additional Testing and Procedures: Testing to evaluate, diagnose, or manage a diagnosed pathology. Additional testing and procedures may be independent from or in addition to a comprehensive eye exam. These tests may include Fundus Photography, Extended Ophthalmoscopy, Gonioscopy, Visual Fields, Pachymetry, Eye Lash Epilation, Removal of Foreign Bodies, Serial Tonometry, Punctal Occlusion and Pupilometry. These will be billed to your major medical insurance.
